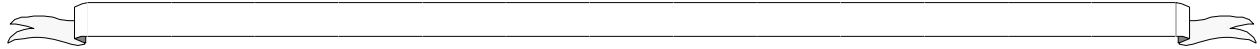
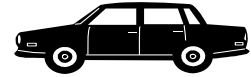




TEEN DRIVER CONTRACT



Realizing the awesome responsibilities and inherent dangers of driving the family cars, I hereby agree to the following conditions in exchange for this great joy and privilege:

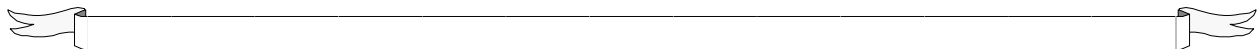
- _____ 1. I will always *without exception* wear my seatbelt.
